Engie Peru

Results in line with our estimates, amid stronger liquidity and leverage metrics

Revenues came in line with our estimate (-2.6% y/y), mainly on lower physical demand of energy from both regulated and non-regulated clients (-2% y/y) and lower sales of energy to the national grid (COES). COGS ex. D&A fell in line with revenues (-2.9% y/y) as the company purchased a lower amount of energy from the spot market (-33% y/y) at a lower average marginal cost during the quarter, which offset a higher consumption of natural gas associated to a substantial increase in Engie's thermal generation in 1Q20. As a result, EBITDA came slightly better than our estimates, although it fell 9.5% y/y mainly due to nonrecurrent sales of inventory and non-core assets in 1Q19. Excluding this event, recurrent EBITDA and recurrent net income fell 2.5% and 4.0% y/y, respectively (actual net income diminished 12.9% y/y, also in line with our estimates). The company has signed 120MW of new contracts and extensions of existing contracts as of Mar20, and it has increased its number of non-regulated clients by 18.6% y/y. Although 2Q20 results would be hit by the contraction in energy demand mainly from free clients (as in the entire generation segment due to the national lockdown on Covid-19 concerns), energy and power sales would gradually recover starting in mid-May. Besides, Engie has improved its liquidity and leverage metrics in Mar20 vs Dec19, including its cash balance (from USD 92mn to USD 103mn), which coupled with stable medium term revenues based on recently signed contracts and currently attractive entry levels for the stock price makes us maintain our Hold recommendation.

Engie's revenues reached USD 128.6mn in 1Q20 (-2.6% y/y). Physical demand of energy from both regulated and non-regulated clients fell 2% y/y, while sales of energy to the national grid (COES) also diminished. The number of non-regulated clients increased 18.6% y/y to 83. Engie's share in the generation market as of March 2020 rose to 11.8% (+2.3 p.p. y/y) and its market share in effective power remained flat at 19.7%.

EBITDA and net income in line with our estimates. COGS ex. D&A fell 2.9% y/y due to lower purchases of energy from the spot market (-33% y/y) at a lower average marginal cost in 1Q20, which offset a higher consumption of natural gas due to higher thermal generation y/y. In addition, SG&A expenses rose 3.7% y/y on higher provisions on accounts receivable and tax charges, which offset y/y reductions of 1.8% in personnel expenses and 7.5% in third-party services. Excluding sales of inventory and non-core assets in 1Q19, recurrent EBITDA and recurrent net income fell 2.5% and 4.0% y/y, respectively.
