


In Q3 2018 YTD ENGIE Energia Perú was the first private player of the sector accounting for 20% of the total capacity and 9% of the total energy generation

ENGIE Energía Peru is the largest private power producer in Peru with 2,497 MW of installed capacity, which accounts for +20% of the total capacity of the country. The generating complex is comprised by 8 plants located in four different regions of the country.

Organic growth in different technologies






