


Transmission lines



Dividend Policy

• In March 2024, the Board of Directors approved dividends of 30.2 MUSD, of which 15.2 MUSD was paid in November 2023, so the resulting balance distributed was equivalent to 15 MUSD. In addition, the amendments to paragraphs c), d) and f) of the Dividend Policy approved by the General Shareholders' Meeting held on October 1, 2015 were approved.
